#### Do You?

Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in holy baptism:

to live among God's faithful people,

to hear the word of God and share in the Lord's supper,

to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed,

to serve all people, following the example of Jesus,

and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

On Sunday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, we will witness our traditional Rite of Confirmation as part of the worship service. The more accurate name for this event, I would argue, is Affirmation of Baptism.

In our Lutheran tradition, we believe that Baptism is a sign of the saving grace God has done and is doing in our lives and in the world. We baptize people of all ages - newborn babies to older adults - because it's not about anything we've done, but rather what God has done. In that sacrament

ask God to help and guíde me.

the baptized person is surrounded, not only by the pastor and their *I* will, and *I* family, but by sponsors, godparents, the congregation, and the whole body of Christ. If the person being baptized is unable to speak for themselves, then promises are made on behalf of them by those surrounding and supporting them.

The annual Rite of Confirmation, then, is an opportunity for the youth of our church to affirm the promises that were made on their behalf. It's the time that we, while not walking away from them, are placing the responsibility of those promises into their own hands. It's truly a gift to witness this event.

However, it's not just a one-time event. Those youth and all of us are invited each and every day to affirm and renew those baptismal promises. Not by being rebaptized, but by remembering what God is doing and how we respond in every day of our life.

I hope you'll join us on June 8<sup>th</sup> as we celebrate this milestone for our eighth grade youth as they together answer, I will, and I ask God to help and guide me.



#### SYNOD ASSEMBLY



### COUNCIL CONTINUED

Propane Tanks: Josh, Justin and Jake have procured and are ready to move 3 propane tanks in order to be able to purchase propane at the lowest cost.

Siding on Storage Building: The siding will need measurements after roof is complete. Estimated cost is \$2,000.00.

Cemetery: Damage has been taken care of. Now waiting on granite monuments to be installed.

Elevette: It will need to be removed before next inspection. Space will be used for closet storage.

Windows in Parsonage: The windows have been ordered and work should begin soon by Truman Yoder.

Property Cleanup: Cleanup on the property behind the church is being done by Frank Root.

Worship: Will meet at a later date.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Church Secretary Position: Is still open.

Constitution: The Constitution Committee consisting of Jancie Gerken, Emily Kullman, Krista Poe and Jean Healan will be updating the constitution. The constitution has not been updated since 1995 and is need of revision.

Insurance: Council will be looking into finding a new Insurance Company to cover the church and property.

Fence: There will be a fence going from the corner of the basement over to the Fellowship Hall to enclose the propane tanks. A bid was received and accepted from Nicholas Dieckman for \$2,111.00. Now waiting to hear back from Nicholas.

Special Meeting: Council held a special meeting on April 6 to begin discussion about the Luetien property. Tom Oelrichs has been contacted and given a contract for the land. Asking price is \$82,500. The building on the land will need to be removed at an estimated cost of \$10,000 to \$12,000. Rov has spoken with the Mayor about zoning issues if there were to be a daycare. The Mayor didn't think there would be a problem, but if needed to be rezoned the cost would be \$100. There will be a meeting of the congregation on Sunday, April 26 after worship.

Adjournment was at 9:06pm with the Lord's Prayer. The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 14, 2025 at 7:00pm.


